## ACTIVITIES 2013

**Trips to the bay** – a 4x4 return transfer to the bay (excluding gate fees) costs R100pp (park gate fees are R30 pp).

You can chill out on the beach or for a little extra do the following activities :

- **Snorkelling** - this is one of the top 10 snorkelling sites in Africa – the clear warm waters are perfect. Snorkel gear extra R50pp
- **Fish trap visits** – one of the traditional fish trap owners, whose family has been in the area for generations, will take you to his fish traps and explain how they work. He will show you how they are made and after explaining how he spears the fish, you are encouraged to try and catch one yourself. What you catch you keep – we can prepare it for your dinner. Extra R75pp
- **Canoeing** – the community guides will take you out for an easy paddle on these beautiful waterways. Extra R150pp (min 2)

(If you are fit and like to hike down to the bay (approx 45 mins), the extra price plus the gate fee will be all it will cost to do these activities).

**Hiking** – Short walks or longer hikes in the region. Rate for the guide from R200 to R350 per hike (no pp charge).

**Visit to local school** – meet and talk to local kids in the classroom. R50pp (gets donated straight to the school). \* Termtime only!

**Elephant Safaris** – in Tembe Elephant Reserve. This small but unique nearby reserve lies on the border between South Africa and Mozambique. It is home to the BIG 5, and is especially known for its LARGE elephants, and is also home to the endangered Suni, as well as other more common African wildlife species. The trip is about 5 hours in total, including transit time (self drive). From R350-600pp

**Mozambique day trips** – on this day trip we take you into Mozambique for a 4x4 excursion. From R450 pp. This price **excludes** visas (R650 pp for non-Southern African countries).

\* An optional extra is to go out for a scenic trip on the ocean. There is plenty of marine wildlife to be seen. If conditions allow there is a possibility of swimming with dolphins. Price for the ocean trip R330pp (subject to change without notice).

**Turtle tours** – nesting season is between November and February. Cross the lake in the early evening by boat, and take a walking tour with trained community guides in search of nesting loggerhead and leatherback turtles. c. R450pp, next season price TBC.

**Boat trips** – launching at 3<sup>rd</sup> lake we enjoy the waterways of this large lake system. Price on request.
