General starting times (hippo and croc): *Morning Tours 07h30 summer, 08:00 winter*
Afternoon Tours 14h30 summer, 14:00 winter

1. Full day tours include snorkelling thus start time is varied due to low tide times. Please phone with a date for confirmation.
2. Items guests need to bring with include: Hat, sunglasses, towel, change of clothes, sun cream and a raincoat or a suitable jacket for cold and wet conditions.
3. All trips are interpretive tours describing the surroundings on and off the water, including the animal and birdlife spotted.
4. All tours are weather dependant.
5. No children under 12 years old.

1) Honeymoon Bend Kayak Safari (Hippo and Croc trip): R290-00 pp

Meet the guide at the boat-locker slipway where we commence the tour.

The guide will take you on a relaxed paddle around the Honeymoon Bend area (below the bridge) where he will talk to you about the wildlife and nature you see there.

We stop roughly half way to have a cold drink and a snack at a suitable spot on the shoreline.

The kayaks are 2-man sea kayaks and the tour lasts around two and a half hours depending on the fitness of the paddlers.

2) Full Day Cape Vidal Safari (Wetland trip): R525-00 per person

This day trip is a really great way to experience the best of the southern wetland park. It combines beach, bush and the lake system in a tour that includes snorkelling, kayaking and a game drive, as well as some relaxation time at the beach. We include a light lunch and one of the picnic sites. The tides play a part in the timings, and snorkelling is only possible when low tide is between 08h30 and 16h30, unless the sea is very flat. We can advise timings if you let us know what date you are keen to go.

3) Half Day Cape Vidal Snorkel: R395-00 per person

A half- day (4 hour) trip to snorkel at Cape Vidal. Snorkelling is best around low tide so times vary, please enquire. Transport, gate fees, snorkelling equipment and refreshments are provided.

4) Catalina Bay: R395-00 per person

A half- day (4 hour) trip to kayak on Catalina Bay (part of Lake St Lucia where it widens out to give a large view of the lake, situated within the iSimangaliso Wetland Park). This offers a more remote kayaking experience, in an area not frequented by other visitors to the park. Transport, gate fees, kayaking equipment and refreshments are provided.
