



LOCATION

Chundukwa is situated on the grassy banks of the Zambezi River, just 25km upstream from the mighty Victoria Falls and 35minutes drive from Livingstone airport. Our stilted chalets boast stunning views across the river to Chundu Island and beyond. This stretch of the river is home to many Hippo, crocodile and a wide variety of birds. Elephant are often found munching the foliage around the lodge.

ACCOMMODATION

The main lodge comprises of 5 open-fronted stilted chalets, named after birds commonly found in the area (Bee-eater, Honeyguide, Francolin, Jacana and Kingfisher)

All of our chalets can be arranged with twin or king-sized beds.

Two of the chalets (Kingfisher & Honeyguide) are recently built and have fully en-suite bathrooms. The other three have a 4metre wooden walkway between the bedroom and their own private bathrooms.

The Kingfisher can work as a triple or indeed can sleep 4 guests when required and the Honeyguide is our Honeymoon Suite which has it's own private sun/dining deck. All Honeymooners receive a bottle of sparkling wine in their room on arrival and special turn down service.

All chalets have uninterrupted river views, mosquito nets and fans.

We also have the 3-bedroomed Chundu cottage for families or groups of friends. It has two bathrooms, a dining deck, plunge pool and great river views.

It is not open-fronted and can be completely closed for guests with young children.

All our rates include full board which consists of:

Full cooked breakfast, Light lunch and a 3-course dinner.

For full day excursions we can prepare a packed lunch.

Home-style cooking, incorporating fresh Zambian produce.

We can cater for any special dietary requirement once notified at least 7 days in advance.

Meals can be taken either at the main table or at a private table.

FAMILY POLICY

Families are very welcome to stay at the main lodge, however the open-fronted nature of the chalets and dining area is not suitable for children under 5 years.

WHAT TO BRING

Chundukwa Lodge is located in a malarial region-we recommend that you see your doctor 1 month prior to travelling for a prescription of prophylactics. The use of mosquito repellent during your stay is also strongly advised.

Wearing long-sleeved tops and trousers in the evenings will also help protect against mosquito bites.

Guests are also advised to bring plenty of sunscreen (especially when white water rafting), sunglasses, a hat, comfortable shoes for game walks and rafters and a w/proof bag for cameras, etc. when viewing the Falls.

Summer (Sept.-April) with October being very hot. Rainy season runs from Nov.-April, a light raincoat may be useful.

Winter (May-August) warm clothes including an anorak for early morning trips or evenings around the fire.

Glasses for those who wear contacts as dust may irritate eyes.

HOW TO GET THERE

By Air

You can reach Livingstone by flying internally from the capital, Lusaka with Proflight or via Johannesburg with British Airways or South African Airways

The lodge is located just 35minutes drive from the Airport.

By Road

From Lusaka-Drive through Livingstone town, turning right at the traffic lights in the direction of Kazungula. From there drive through the National Park for 22Km, turning left at the Chundukwa road sign. Take this dirt road for 1km, past the Polo field and right into the carpark

From Botswana-After crossing the border at Kasane, drive 3Kms to the T-junction, turning right for Livingstone. Continue for 45Kms, turn right at the Chundukwa road sign. Take this dirt road for 1km, past the Polo field and right into the carpark

CURRENCY & VISA REQUIREMENTS

The local currency is the Zambian Kwacha, US\$/STG£/€/Rand can be exchanged at local bureau de change offices.

We accept Visa and Mastercard.

Most passport holders require a visa to enter Zambia. This costs US\$50pp for single entry and US\$80pp for double entry and can be bought at the point of entry.

Since 1st October 2011, South African Health authorities require all passengers arriving from Zambia (even in transit) to hold a valid Yellow Fever Vaccination certificate.
